HOW TO ORGAINISE YOUR OWN PRIVATE SOUL TOUR

Here are all the details you need to know about running your own introductory Soul Tour course.

- Anyone can organise an introductory Soul Tour course for their group, whether workmates, friends or a church. Participants should be aged 16-30yrs.
- The registration fee is \$195 per person. This fee is invoiced to the organiser in bulk on the first day of the event. Every person attending the course is required to pay the registration fee including the organiser, if they are attending.
- As the organiser, you will need to provide a suitable venue at your own expense.
 Everyone in attendance will need to be seated at tables with plenty of room. Our presenters also require a table, chair, whiteboard and whiteboard markers. In addition, the organiser will also be responsible for providing tea, coffee, and a few biscuits for morning and afternoon tea breaks.
- There is no maximum number of people who can attend a course (we have had 100+ several times). However, the minimum number of participants on any course is 12. All of our travel expenses are covered from the registration fees.
 For this reason, the orgainser will be invoiced for a minimum of 12 participants even if fewer than 12 people attend.
- The most common timetable for our introductory course is Friday evening (6-9pm) and all day Saturday (10am-9pm). If this timetable is not suitable for your group we are happy to the negotiate course hours with you. If you are based in Auckland or Christchurch, there is a possibility that the course could be spread over a few weeks as day or evening sessions. We require a total of 12 teaching hours to complete our introductory course.
